


REFLECTIONS ON A QUARTER: A COMMITMENT TO CONTINUOUS VALUE CREATION

BUDDING CHESS LEGENDS: THE INTER-SCHOOLS CHALLENGE'S PHENOMENAL TALENTS

- Quantitative: Thinking with "figures"
- Non-verbal: Thinking with "shapes"
- Spatial: Thinking with "shapes and space"

The examination is designed to assess a candidate's abilities rather than what they may have learned in school, making it an excellent measure of potential.

CHESS IN EDUCATION: INSPIRING CRITICAL THINKING AND BEYOND AT COLLEGE 360, AKURE, ONDO STATE

Interview with Mr. Oluwatosin Agbanimu Proprietor, College 360

The Inter-Schools Chess Challenge, hosted by Dinamico Consulting, took place at the prestigious Christ Event Center, located on Oke Ijebu Road in Akure, Ondo State, on Saturday, September 23, 2023.

As we delved into the background of this remarkable achievement, we had the privilege of conducting an insightful interview with the proprietor of College 360, Mr. Oluwatosin Oluwole Agbanimu, who holds a degree in Mining Engineering from the Federal University of Technology Akure, Ondo State.

DC: Can you tell us about your background in chess and how your personal experience with the game influenced your decision to make it a priority in College 360's curriculum?

OA: My background in chess stemmed out of my days as a tutorial teacher. I just wanted something to keep the students entertained. And seeing how it builds the cognitive capabilities of a person, I made it mandatory for all.

DC. How do you ensure that students at College 360 have access to chess education and opportunities to develop their skills within the school?

OA: We make sure we have numerous chess boards in school, and also students must play daily as well as we organize internal competitions termly.

DC. Could you describe any specific initiatives or strategies that you've implemented to promote chess among students and make it an integral part of their educational journey?

OA: Through internal competitions within the school.

DC. What role do you believe chess plays in enhancing students' critical thinking and problem-solving abilities?

OA: Chess plays an important role as it creates thinking in a calculative manner and life-applicable situations.

DC. How has the integration of chess into the curriculum affected the academic performance and overall development of the students at College 360?

OA: It has affected them tremendously. Students who most times play chess become academically better and approach life differently.

OA: We are planning on having a community chess club beyond the school to enable outside participants to engage in the game, and the school students will be the teachers. They learn as they play.

DC. Beyond academic success, what broader life lessons do you believe students can learn through their engagement with chess?

OA: A lot - business, politics, power, succession, critical analysis, etc.

DC. Lastly, how do you see the future of chess education in schools, and what role do you believe it will play in shaping young minds?

OA: Well, in Ondo state, I hope parents wake up. Chess is key to academic performance. Schools should learn to embrace it. Well, if they don't, the few of us who do will lead in all aspects.
